ANTHONY DOWNEY ('89) 1985-1987:



After competing in the Port Macquarie Ironman event in 2010 and again in 2012 he qualified in the Cairns Ironman to represent Australia in the world Ironman championship at Kona in Hawaii in October 2012.

There were over 1800 competitors from all over the world both men and women.

The event comprises 3.8km swim, followed by 180kms bike leg and concludes with a 42km marathon. He not only finished but also in the top third of the field. His time was 10hrs and 33minutes 19seconds.

Anthony left Mazenod at the end of year ten to take up an apprenticeship as a motor mechanic.

After finishing it he travelled overseas. He finally settled in Melbourne where he decided to pursue a career in finance. After gaining entry to the University of Melbourne he studied part time, graduating with a degree in Economics and Finance in 2010. It was about this time that he developed a strong interest in the Ironman event.

ARNO TESLING (71)

A tin shed next to a construction site and some cleared scrub. This was how Mazenod started. The shed was our classroom, the construction site became our next classroom and then became the first chapel.

The cleared scrub after a period of much root picking and burning became the oval.

I attended three years at Mazenod, the final year as a boarder and spent some of the school holidays at the school being the only occupant looking after the watering of the oval.

After leaving Mazenod, I chose a career as a carpenter and pursued my love of art at the Perth School of Art at night.

In 1973 I headed north and spent 7 years as a driller for Mt Newman mining and did lots of exploring, with not a bitumen road in any direction.

While in Newman I was married and had two children.

In 1980 with the family in tow we headed further north to Broome, 1000 kms of dirt roads and flooded rivers, which took us over a week to get there.

In Broome we set up a Mango plantation and settled down to Kimberley life for the next 27 years. During this time many adventures were had, another child was born, a 400 km mail run, working on stations, building homes in isolated aboriginal communities, Mango wine was produced, painting, sculpture and fishing were also undertaken.

In 2007, with my current partner, we embarked on an adventure following the Savannah Way over the top of OZ, settling in Tannum Sands, Queensland.

Here I find myself gainfully employed in a quarry, however spend as much time as possible painting, sculpturing, fishing, and kayaking. Also travelling, we have ventured from Rome to Moscow and a lot of places in between. A great time was had trekking in the Himalayas of Bhutan.
